TUG-OF-WAR

You need:

one bead kebab,

□ 1 dice (1–6)

 \square 2 players



How to play:

1. split the beads in half - 10 each side

- 2. first player rolls the dice and takes that number of beads from their partner
- 3. take turns rolling 'dice, taking beads from each other's total
- 4. winner is the person with 20 beads

What is the maths?

- Subitising recognising dots on the dice as total
- O Visualising numbers counting beads in groups other than one by one
- O Counting on "How many more do you need?"
- O Partialising numbers recognising 20 can be made up of many different combinations
- Facts to ten facts to five building on knowledge of 4 and 1 is 5; 3 and 2 is 5 etc
